Deniz's message:

This coming Sunday is Palm Sunday which marks the beginning of Holy Week leading up to the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus (Luke 19:28-44). When Jesus entered Jerusalem through the Mount of Olives, on a colt brought by his disciples, the crowd cheered and praised God for the amazing works he had been doing, and they cried out, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!" But Jesus cried over Jerusalem.

People praised Jesus, but their lives were not always consistent with what their mouths uttered. We cry for peace to the Giver of Peace in heaven and on earth, but our world does not reflect our longing. Jesus cries over the world and over all that mankind do to each other.

My prayer, as we approach Holy Week, is that we may be able to identify with Jesus and cry with Him for peace to reign over our world.
