Deniz's Message

In memory of Roger Thomas Forster

I met Roger in 1985, when I was a student who had just come into a wonderful relationship with Jesus and wanted to be baptised. Roger interviewed me for my baptism and baptised me at Cottage Green Baptist Church in London. Later, I became a part of Ichthus Christian Fellowship and trained for ministry. Roger's teaching and leadership have played a pivotal part in my walk with Jesus. He was an amazing theologian, leader, radical thinker and preacher who had incredible respect for absolutely everybody and was one of the most humble Christian leaders I have ever met. His knowledge and understanding of the Word of God were incredible. I was able to fall in love with Jesus, because Roger introduced a radical movement in which Christianity made sense to me.

Roger T Forster studied Mathematics and Theology at Cambridge University. He was the founder of Ichthus Christian Fellowship, which was a part of the British New Church Movement and he was one of the pioneers in church planting.

The last time I saw Roger, his voice had grown weaker, but the unquenchable fire of God kept burning brightly in him as he spoke the truth of the Word of God into our spirits with great power, which did not require a loud voice.

Roger passed away and went to Glory on 17 January 2024 at the age of 90. His ministry shaped the lives of thousands of people including mine. I will be eternally grateful to him for all the days of my life.

The world has lost an incredible leader, but I am sure Roger would have said,

"To me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain."
