Where we live, there are numerous cattlegrids to keep cattle, sheep and horses out of our villages. If they had free access to these, they could cause a lot of damage to themselves as well as to the area. The grids are there to protect them and us.

Parents of toddlers have stair-gates not to stop the curious, adventurous children from exploring, but to protect them from falling and getting hurt.

God's rules and regulations – the Ten Commandments – are there to protect us. Why? Because we are vulnerable human beings whom He loves and wants the best for. This means staying close to Him in a world which could easily draw us away and tempt us into things that would harm us, God is a safe haven.
